Re: Italian Red Crosses contribution to the Haiti earthquake operation

I would like to take this opportunity to share the International Federation's sincere appreciation of Italian Red Cross's (IRC) contribution to the multi-lateral emergency response operation in support of Haitian Red Cross and its people.

Following the January 12 earthquake that hit Port au Prince and the surrounding areas, IRC quickly responded positively to our Emergency Response Units' (ERU) alert for assistance and made available its Base Camp ERU for deployment.

The deployment of an ERU is a challenge in any operation, let alone in response to an event such as the Haiti earthquake. In addition, deploying an ERU for the first time in a multi-lateral context usually poses challenges to all players involved. This operation was no exception to that 'rule' It goes without saying, however, that IRC not only fulfilled the expectations raised following our cooperation over the past three years and the preparation for an eventual ERU deployment, but showed extreme flexibility in this operation. We like to particularly mention the readiness to play a decisive role in the very early days of the preparation and set-up of the Base Camp on-site, the supplying of services for the other Base Camp and, last but not least, IRC's immediate willingness to cater for a very considerably higher number of RC/RC staff, both expatriates and local, when needs vastly surpassed what we expected on the outset of the operation.

While there remains work to be done to further standardise the Base Camp ERUs as they exist today, there is no doubt about the fact that IRC's contribution has been a decisive factor in the well being of hundreds of RC/RC staff throughout what is now a seven months lasting Base Camp operation that, thanks to IRC, will continue for several more.
